

DIMENSIONAL WHIMSY

Block# 5



A. Yellow Fabric:

- 1 - 4-7/8" Square
- 8 - 2-1/2" Squares

B. Blue Fabric:

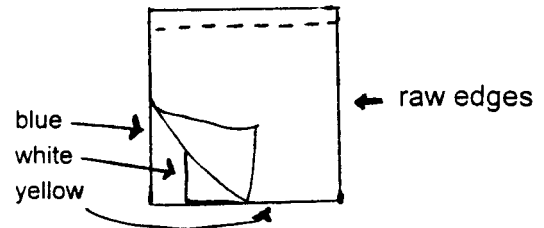
- 1 - 4-7/8" Square
- 8 - 2-1/2" Squares

C. White Background:

- 2 - 4-7/8" Square
- 1 - 4-1/2" Square
- 8 - 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" Rectangles

CONSTRUCTION:

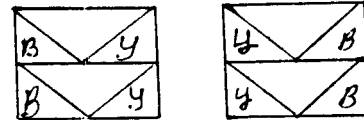
1. First, make the corner half-square triangles. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the white 4-7/8" squares. Place one right sides together on the blue 4-7/8" square, and sew 1/4" on each side of the diagonal line. Cut down the diagonal line making two blue and white half square triangles. Repeat using the yellow 4-7/8" square.



Make 4 then reverse blue & yellow and make 4 more.

2. Make 8 dimensional flying geese. For the first 4 fold a white rectangle in half, right side out. Place a blue 2-1/2" square right side up, then the folded white rectangle, then a yellow square with right side facing the white. All raw edges should align at right the side of this "sandwich". Sew 1/4" seam along TOP of the yellow square through all pieces. Open the white, and press into a flying geese unit. For the second four, repeat with yellow square on the bottom and blue on top.

3. Sew geese together into four squares - - - two will have blue on the right side and yellow on the left, and the other two will be reversed.



4. Place in normal nine-patch order, then sew into rows first, and sew rows together to form the 12-1.2" block.
