

DIMENSIONAL WHIMSY

Block # 1

Finished size of quilt – 65”x82”

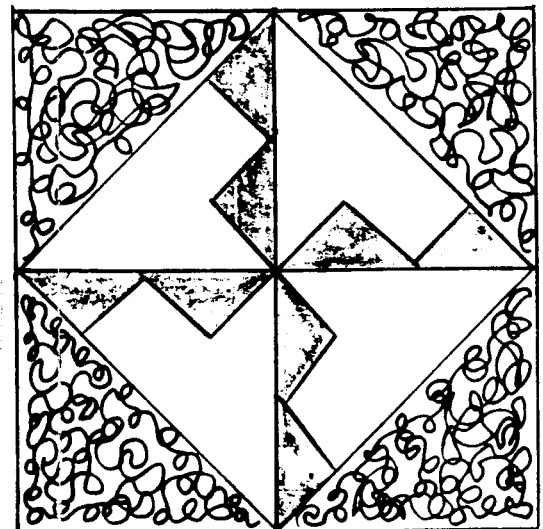
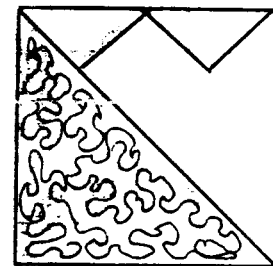
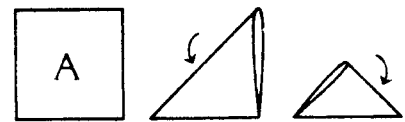
- A. White Print:
2 - 6-7/8" Squares
- B. Blue & Yellow Print:
2 - 6-7/8" Squares

- C. Yellow Pinwheels:
8 - 3-1/2" Squares

CONSTRUCTION:

1. Start by making four large half-square triangles: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the two white squares. Place the white square right sides together with the blue & yellow square. Sew 1/4" on either side of the diagonal line, then cut down the diagonal line to form two half square triangles. Repeat to make a total of four 6-1/2" half square triangles.
2. Now make the pinwheel. Fold yellow squares in half diagonally with wrong sides together and press. Fold again into smaller triangles, and press again. Place two folded yellow triangles on one of your half-square triangles with raw edges of triangles lined up with the white edge of the half-square triangle (REFER TO DIAGRAM FOR EXACT PLACEMENT). The two triangles should overlap slightly, as the overlap will be in your 1/4" seam. Pin or baste into place. Repeat to make four half-square triangle units each having two yellow folded triangles.
3. Arrange pieces together as per diagram. Sew into rows first, then sew rows together. Finished block should be 12-1/2" square.

Borders are 4 1/2" and 6 1/2"

If you are making a two-color quilt, and you buy 2 1/2 yds. of one color and 2 1/2 yds. of a second color, you will have enough fabric for the sashing and the borders. Buy several fat quarters, and you're ready to make Dimensional Whimsy.
