The deadline for Board nominations is the end of March 2025. The voting will take place at the June 2025 Guild meeting.

-Reminder for the 2025 Challenge, which is the Initials Challenge. Use your initials to make a quilt – one for a color, one for a block name, and one for the quilting (stitching) design. (It doesn't matter which order). Your initial can be a maiden name or a nickname. Your choices should be a noticeable portion of the quilt, but feel free to use as many other colors, blocks, and quilting designs as you want. Quilts can be up to 40 inches on a side. We'll show the quilts and award prizes at the September 2025 meeting. Have fun with it!


