

- -Cathy Fennell announced that there will be a UFO Challenge in 2026 and provided signup sheets. Members who want to participate need to fill out the 12 slots on the sheet with unfinished projects they would like to complete next year in preparation for the 2026 Quilt Show. The first UFO number will be chosen at the September meeting and will be due at the October meeting.


