- GO! Strip Cutter-1¼" (¾" Finished) (55109)
- GO! Strip Cutter-3" (2½" Finished) (55084)
- GO! Stems & Leaves (55331) optional

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1 (White)—1⅓ yards
- Fabric 2 (Floral Triangles)—1¼ yards
- Fabric 3 (Border & Binding)—1⅝ yards
- Fabric 4 (Flower)—⅝ yard
- Fabric 5 (Circle)—⅓ yard
- Fabric 6 (Star)—¼ yard
- Fabric 7 (Curved Diamond)—¼ yard
- Fabric 8 (Green)—1⅛ yards
- Backing—4 yards
- Batting—68" x 68"
- Paper backed fusible web—4 yards

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

NOTE: Apply fusible web product to wrong side of selected fabrics, following manufacturer's instructions, before cutting for fusible appliqué.

Fabric 1:

- Cut 5—13" squares
- Cut 6—3" strips x width of fabric (WOF)
Sub cut 16—3" x 14" rectangles

Fabric 2:

- Cut 1—25" square
- Cut 2—15½" squares

Fabric 3:

- Cut 6—6" strips x WOF
- Cut 6—3" strips x WOF

Fabric 4:

- Cut 5—flowers (with fusible web)

Fabric 5:

- Cut 5—circles (with fusible web)
- Cut 1—3" strip x WOF
Sub cut 12—3" squares

Fabric 6:

- Cut 5—stars (with fusible web)

Fabric 7:

- Cut 5—curved diamonds (with fusible web)

Fabric 8:

- Cut 10 pairs (mirror image)—leaves (with fusible web)
- Cut 35—curved diamonds (with fusible web)
- Cut 5—1¼" bias strips for stems
- Cut 10—1¼" x 12½" strips for framing borders
- Cut 10—1¼" x 14½" strips for framing borders
- Cut 8—1¼" strips for folded borders

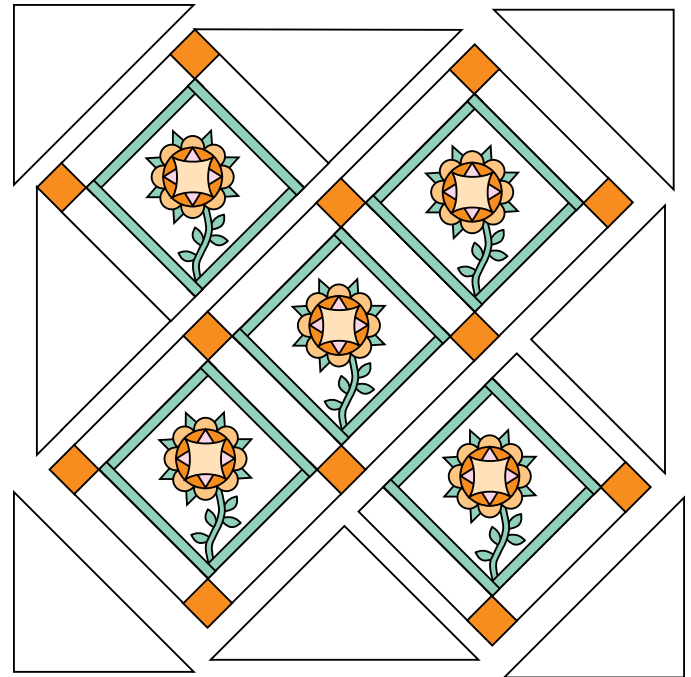
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SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Free hand draw curved stem line on each of 13" Fabric #1, background squares or use GO!® Stems & Leaves (55331).
2. Press Fabric #8, 1¼" x 12" green bias stems in half wrong sides together.
3. Place raw edges against left edge of stem line. Sew with scant ¼" seam.
4. Fold edge over raw edge and pin in place. Edge stitch folded edge with matching thread.
5. Stack layers of Harrison Rose flower in order: Flower, Circle, Star, Diamond and Leaves. Tuck back triangles under flower. Fuse pieces in place.
6. Appliqué stitch around outside edges of flower shapes with a straight, zigzag or blanket stitch.
7. Square blocks to 12½" x 12½".
8. Pin and sew one Fabric #8, 1¼" x 12½" strip to one side of block. Pin and sew another Fabric #8, 1¼" x 12½" strip to opposite side of block. Pin and sew one Fabric #8, 1¼" x 14½" strip to one side of block. Pin and sew another Fabric #8, 1¼" x 14½" strip to opposite side of block. Press toward fabric #3. Finished block should measure 14" x 14".
9. Repeat steps to remaining blocks.
10. Pin and sew one Fabric #1, 3" x 14" rectangle to left and right sides of four squares. Finished squares should measure 19" x 14".
11. To create the center row, pin and sew one 19" x 14" block to the 14" x 14" block. Pin an additional 19" x 14" block to the opposite side of the 14" x 14" block, and sew.

TO CREATE LATTICE STRIPS

1. For single lattice, pin and sew two Fabric #5, 3" squares to opposite ends of one Fabric #1, 3" x 14" rectangles.
2. For long lattice, pin and sew one Fabric #5, 3" square to one Fabric #1, 3" x 14" rectangle. Continue to add squares and rectangles until lattice has four 3" squares and three 3" x 14" rectangles (see diagram). Press toward fabric #3. Complete two long lattice strips.



QUILTING AND FINISHING

1. Lay out five blocks on point with lattice and cornerstones.
2. Pin and sew lattice strip on opposite sides of each of the block's hand corner block of the quilt.
3. Pin and sew lattice strip with cornerstones on opposite side of three blocks as show per layout.
4. Cut one Fabric #2, 25" square on both diagonals into four triangles. Place on sides.
5. Cut two Fabric #2, 15½" squares on one diagonal into four triangles. Place at corners.
6. Sew blocks together and press toward lattice.
7. Sew rows together and press toward triangles.
8. Square outside edge, leaving a ½" away from points.
9. Piece 1¼" x 12½" folded border strips together. Press in half wrong sides together.
10. Line up raw edge of folded border with raw edge of top. Sew to two opposite sides of top with long 3.0 stitch length. Trim even with top and press. Do not open.
11. Sew remaining two sides, overlapping folded border in corners. Press. Do not open.
12. Sew outside Border.
13. Quilt and bind.
